



## RENTAL BOAT & CHARTER TIPS AND GUIDELINES

### Preparation and Planning for a Pleasurable Day!

1. Try to arrive 30-40 minutes early. Many times we can get you out on the water early and it's free! Highly recommend you tell your group to arrive 1 hour early. Too often boats sit in our marina waiting for the last person or two to arrive and then depart late.....that's not free!
2. Provide everyone in your group our address, directions and this list at least one day prior to your reservation.
3. Alcohol is permitted on any boat on Lake Travis. Even the boat driver can be drinking. NOBODY can be intoxicated. Those caught WILL receive a BWI (Boating while Intoxicated) and passengers can receive a public intoxication ticket and can also be arrested.
4. Do not bring glass bottles! They are prohibited.
5. Marina ship store sells ice, snacks, cold drinks & sodas and basic lake essentials.
6. Bring your own ice chests. All boats have bimini tops for shade. Rental boat stereos are unreliable. Bring your own music.
7. Our staff will provide the required pre-departure boat/waverunner safety orientation and checklist before you will be allowed to leave the marina.
8. All life jackets are provided for you. Kids under 13 are required to wear a life jacket at all times. Nobody should walk on or around any marina in bare feet!
9. Pets are never allowed on any rental boat or charter.
10. Always stay in the center of the lake! Always make very wide turn around points. Steep shoreline means deep water (GOOD). Flat or low sloping shoreline means shallow water (BAD). A damaged propeller is a \$180 charge to you.
11. Plan on returning on time. Insist, before you leave the marina, that your group respect your time of return requirement. The charge is \$10 per minute late. Don't be the irresponsible group that is late and leaves another family waiting.
